SCIENCE & RESEARCH

Plant pathologists of Nebraska discovered a genetic switch that regulates rice plant infection by blast agent *Magnaporthe oryzae*, signaling to the fungus that it is in a nutrition rich environment. This signal will trigger infection and establishment of the disease. The scientists have now renewed their efforts to control the switch and the related processes so that a targeted control of the disease can be developed
