Tariff quotas: Commission issues new regulations

COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) 2020/760 of 17 December 2019 supplementing Regulation (EU) No 1308/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the rules for the administration of import and export tariff quotas subject to licences and supplementing Regulation (EU) No 1306/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the lodging of securities in the administration of tariff quotas.

This Regulation shall apply to the tariff quota periods starting from 1 January 2021 onwards.

COMMISSION IMPLEMENTING REGULATION (EU) 2020/761 of 17 December 2019 laying down rules for the application of Regulations (EU) No 1306/2013, (EU) No 1308/2013 and (EU) No 510/2014 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the management system of tariff quotas with licences.




EU imports amount to 1,300,773 tonnes, in milled equivalent, about 87,700 tonnes (+7%) more than in the previous campaign. Indica rice imports, amounting to 1,052,537 tonnes, were only slightly above the level recorded a year ago (+941 tonnes), while Japonica rice imports increased by around 86,700 tonnes (+54%).

Husked Basmati rice imports amount to 378,579 tonnes, 46,000 tonnes (+14%) more than a year ago: they increased by 17% from Pakistan and by 8% from India.

EU exports amount to 238,177 tonnes, in milled equivalent, 7,100 tonnes, (-3%) less than last year. Italy, with 98,785 tonnes, accounts for 41% of the total volume exported.




In the last week paddy rice transfers by farmers reached 25,828 tonnes: 8,286 tonnes of long A grain, 8,229 tonnes of long B grain, 6,940 tonnes of round grain and 2,373 tonnes of medium grain. The total transfers, amounting to 1,416,820 tonnes and accounting for 91% of the total supply, increased by 85,608 tonnes (+6%) compared to last campaign. There are still 134,444 tonnes of paddy rice to be transferred.

At Commodity Exchange in Vercelli, the paddy prices increased for Selenio (+€5).

Italian imports amount to 96,445 tonnes, in milled equivalent, about 5.000 tonnes (-5%) less than last year. Rice Indica imports, amounting to 90,579 tonnes, account for 94% of the total volume. According to customs declarations imports amount to 98,795 tonnes, about 23.000 tonnes (-19%) less than last year (see table at the bottom).

Italian exports amount to 104,034 tonnes, in milled equivalent, 3,524 tonnes (-3%) less than last year. In the last week, export licences were issued for 1.839 tonnes, of which 790 tonnes to Switzerland.
